Divisions: Youth anglers 6 years and younger; 7-11; 12-18 years. State regulations apply. Bottom fishing only.

Equipment: Adult/child team or anglers may bring their own fishing equipment or the team pier of choice will provide complimentary equipment. No gold hooks.

Amenities Complimentary food & drinks will be available for participants. Each youth angler will receive a gift bag.

Awards Lunch: All first, second and third 1 child and 1 adult teams will be invited to a ceremony that will take place immediately after the tournament at each pier. Overall awards for largest single catch and number of fish caught and released will be recognized at the end of the year awards banquet, that is held on December 9.
